2. Considering the age of the married detenu and the family background and that he was pursuing his studies, we thought that an attempt has to be made to resolve the controversy by referring the matter to the Mediation and Conciliation centre. The trained



mediator had done his best to resolve the problem, but the mediation could not succeed.

3. Since the detenu is a major, we find that there is no illegal detention. Hence, this Habeas Corpus Petition is closed.
