ORDER:

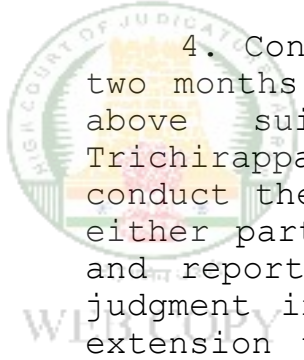

This petition has been listed today for extension of time for disposing O.S.No.233 of 2012 and 88 of 2013

2.This Court has already disposed of the Petition by order dated 07.05.2016, by directing the trial Court to dispose of the suits as expeditiously as preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Thereafter, time was extended.

3. Now, the trial Court seeks further time for disposing the cases. Hence, the matter was listed today.



4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, further two months time is granted to the trial Court for disposal of the above suits. The learned II Additional District Judge, Trichirappalli, shall keep in mind the attitude of the parties and conduct the cases on day-to-day basis without giving adjournment to either parties and dispose of the cases within the prescribed time and report this court within a period of 10 days after passing judgment in the above petition. It is made clear that no further extension will be granted on any ground. Both parties shall give their fullest co-operation for early disposal of the suits.
