In view of the law laid down by this Court in **Sugesan Transport Pvt. Ltd. represented by its Director Rajendra Sheth No.7C, Second Canal Cross Road Gandhi Nagar Adyar, Chennai 600 020 vs. The Assistant Commissioner of Police, J-2, Adyar Police Station, Adyar, Chennai 600 020 and another,** reported in **2016 (2) CTC 286,** the present writ petition is not maintainable. However, the learned Additional Government Pleader submitted that on the complaint given by the husband of the petitioner, a petition enquiry has been conducted in CSR No.117 of 2017 and the same has also been closed.
