O R D E R

This Writ petition has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to issue the Legal Heirship Certificate of the petitioner's father Late.K.Mariappan based on the representation of the petitioner dated 15.05.2017.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondent.

3. Mr. A. Muthukaruppan, learned Additional Government Pleader, takes notice for the respondent. By consent, the Writ petition itself is taken up for final disposal.

4. Though the Writ petition is for issuing a positive direction, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondent to consider the representation/Application for issuance of legal heirship certificate of the petitioner, dated 15.05.2017.
