3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that it would suffice if the proposal of the petitioner through Block Medical Officer is disposed of, on merits and in accordance with law, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

4.In view of the limited scope of the prayer, without going into the merits of the matter, respondents are directed to consider the proposal of the petitioner through Block Medical Officer dated 31.03.2016 on merits and in accordance with law and pass appropriate orders within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5.With the above direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
