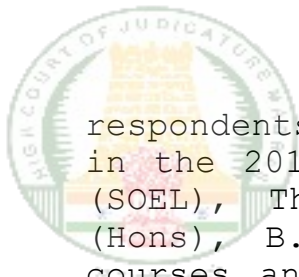

3.In view of the subsequent events, as indicated above, the writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.

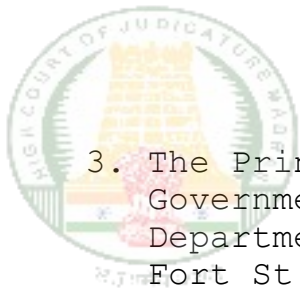
