This Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to direct the respondents to give necessary permission for conducting Rekla Race in the place mentioned therein, by way of issuing a Writ of Mandamus.



2.Mr.M.Govindan, learned Special Government Pleader, has taken notice for the respondents.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has advanced his argument on the basis of the averments made in the petition.

4.The learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents has contended to the effect that Rekla Race mentioned in the petition is not permissible under law.

5.Considering the contention putforth on the side of the respondents and also considering the fact that in a similar writ petition this Court has already rejected similar prayer, this Court feels that the relief sought in the Writ Petition cannot be granted and therefore the same deserves to be dismissed.

6.In fine, this Writ Petition is dismissed. No costs.
