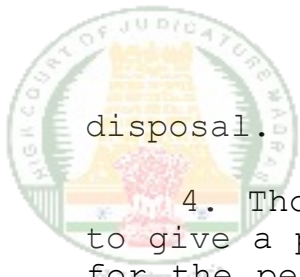

5. Having regard to the limited scope of the prayer, that is now sought before this Court by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the petitioner's case, this Court is inclined to pass the following direction:-

"The respondents are directed to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 24.03.2017, in the light of the G.O.No.408, dated 25.08.2009, and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order."

6. With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
