The respondents are directed to consider and dispose of the petitioner's representations dated 24.07.2015 and 17.12.2015 on merits and in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4.With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
