Heard Mr.E.Balasubramanian, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.K.Guru, learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents 1 to 3 and Mr.D.Sivaraman, learned

The petitioner, who is working as the Advocate's Clerk attached to an Advocate, who is practising at District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate Court, Thirumayam, has come forward with this Writ Petition with a prayer to direct the respondents Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation to stop the buses in front of the Court Complex.

3. It is clear as to whether there is a bus stop in the said area. In any event, if there are sufficient number of passengers to board the bus at that area, the respondent Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation may consider the request of the petitioner in terms of their regulations.

4. Accordingly, we dispose of the Writ Petition by directing the fourth and fifth respondents to consider the representation dated 14.06.2017, given by the petitioner and proceed in accordance with law. No costs.
