ORDER

This writ petition is filed seeking a writ of Mandamus to direct the respondent to survey the petitioner's lands situate in Kambalinaickanpatti, Puduchathiram Post, Ottanchathiram Via, Dindigul West Taluk, Dindigul District, on the basis of the petitioner's representations dated 17.04.2017 and 20.06.2017.

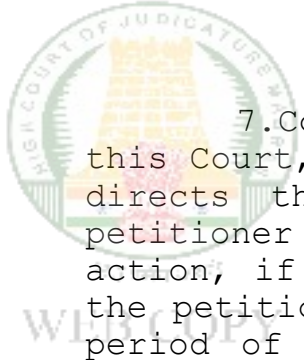
2.Mr.C.Selvaraj, learned Special Government Pleader, takes notice for the respondent.

5.The petitioner made two representation dated 17.04.2017 and 20.06.2017, to the respondent for surveying his lands.

6.The learned Counsel for the petitioner would submit that it would be suffice, if the representations of the petitioner dated 17.04.2017 and 20.06.2017, are disposed of by the respondent as per law.

Considering the limited scope of the relief sought for, this Court, without going into the merits of the petitioner's claim, directs the respondent to consider the representations of the petitioner dated 17.04.2017 and 20.06.2017, and take necessary action, if found fit, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and to all the interested parties, if any, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

8. The writ petition is disposed of as above. No costs.
