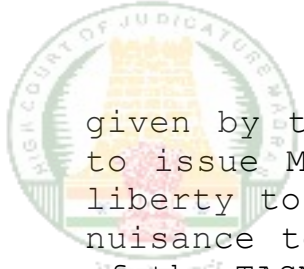

The petitioner filed this writ petition to direct the respondents not to locate the TASMAC Wine shop in survey No. 510/9 and 510/3A situated in Kondanagaram Revenue Village, Tirunelveli Taluk, Tirunelveli District.

2.The counter affidavit filed by the District Manager, TASMAC, Tirunelveli District, indicates that the shop is located beyond the prohibited distance. In view of the facts and figures



given by the District Manager, TASMAC, we do not find any reason to issue Mandamus as prayed for by the writ petitioner. We give liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court, incase there is nuisance to the local residents on the account of the functioning of the TASMAC shop in question.

3.The writ petition is dismissed with the above observation. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
