This writ petition is filed seeking for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to grant adequate protection for construction of compound wall in Old Survey No. 521 in Ward No. 4 Block No. 20 T.S.No. 1846 in Melapalayam, Mayila Kadhar Street (New Town Survey No. 32) based on the petitioners representation dated 24.06.2017.
