Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records pertaining to the impugned order passed by the 2nd respondent in his proceedings in Rc.No.R2/150/2017 dated 28.07.2017 and quash the same; in consequentially direct the respondents to conduct re-measurement of Chest Test for the petitioner and proceed further with the recruitment process in the Common Recruitment for the posts of Grade II Police Constable (Men, Women & /third Gender)/ Grade II Jail Warders (Men & Women) and Firemen for the year 2017.

ORDER

The prayer in the writ petition is for issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records pertaining to the impugned order passed by the 2nd respondent in his proceedings in Rc.No.R2/150/2017 dated 28.07.2017 to quash the same and consequently direct the respondents to conduct re-measurement of Chest Test for the petitioner and proceed further with the



recruitment process in the Common Recruitment for the posts of Grade II Police Constable (Men, Women & /third Gender)/ Grade II Jail Warders (Men & Women) and Firemen for the year 2017.

2.The impugned order has been questioned on the ground that during physical efficiency test, the petitioner's chest had not been measured properly, therefore, the impugned order is liable to be set aside.

3.Considering the said submission, this Court directed the learned Additional Advocate General to produce the videographs taken during selection to the aforementioned posts.

4.Today, when the matter was taken up for hearing, the videographs in respect of chest measurement of the petitioner has been displayed before this Court in the presence of the petitioner and his counsel. The video clipping/recording shows that the petitioner has failed to possess 81 cms of chest, hence, this Court is not inclined to entertain the prayer of the petitioner. Accordingly, this Writ Petition fails and the same is dismissed. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
