ORDER

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the first respondent.

The learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the first respondent, on instructions, submitted that the complaint received from the third respondent against the petitioner was enquired into and closed. Hence, he submitted that the Writ Petition need not be entertained and the same may be closed. The learned Special Government Pleader also produced a copy of the closure report and the same was handed over to the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.
