ORDER

The prayer in the writ petition is for issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the entire records pertaining to the order passed by the 2nd respondent in Rc.No.R2/150/2017 dated 29.07.2017 to quash the same and consequently direct the respondents to order re-testing of the petitioner's height measurement in connection with the recruitment process of appointing Grade-II Police Constables.



2.The impugned order has been questioned on the ground that during physical efficiency test, the petitioner's height had not been measured properly, therefore, the impugned order is liable to be set aside.

3.Considering the said submission, this Court directed the learned Additional Advocate General to produce the videographs taken during selection to the aforementioned posts.

4.Today, when the matter was taken up for hearing, the videographs in respect of height measurement of the petitioner has been displayed before this Court in the presence of the petitioner and his counsel. The video clipping/recording shows that the petitioner has failed to possess minimum 170 cms of height, whereas his height is 166.0 cms, hence, this Court is not inclined to entertain the prayer of the petitioner. Accordingly, this Writ Petition fails and the same is dismissed. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
