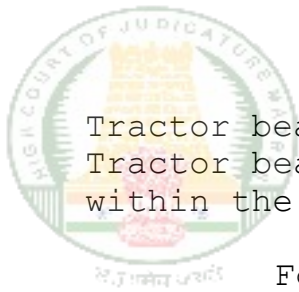

COMMON ORDER

Recording the submission made by the learned Government Advocate, these petitions are disposed of, with liberty to the petitioners to agitate before the Appellate Authority on merits, if so advised, on filing necessary applications, in case of subsistence of their grievance as on date insofar as the impugned orders under challenge are concerned. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
