In the light of the prayer sought for in this Writ Petition and the submissions made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, this Court directs the first respondent to consider the representations of the Petitioner, dated 1.9.2017 and 3.9.2017, on merits and in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. With the above direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
