Finding no response in his favour, the petitioner has come to this Court with the present writ petition.

3.The petitioner immediately after taking part in the certificate verification, should have resorted to legal remedy without doing so, the petitioner cannot approach this Court after two years delay. Hence, this Writ Petition stands dismissed. No costs.
