4. Mr. C. Nagamuthu, learned counsel for the Petitioner would further submit that it would suffice, if a direction is given to the first respondent to consider the representation of the Petitioner, dated 15.06.2017.

5. The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents would submit that the representation of the Petitioner will be considered as per law, within the time frame fixed by this Court.

6. Considering the submission made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, this Court directs the first respondent to consider the representation of the Petitioner, dated 15.06.2017 on merits and in accordance with law and pass orders on the same, after giving notice to the Petitioner and other interested parties, if any, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order

7. With the above direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
