In view of the above, without going into the merits or the contentions made by the petitioner, the respondents 1 and 2 are directed to complete the enquiry by giving personal opportunity to the petitioner and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. The writ petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs.
