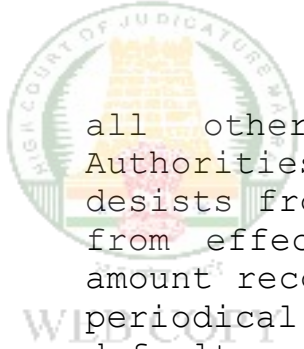

Petitions filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records relating to orders in (1) G.O.Ms.No.241, Finance (PC) Department, dated 22.07.2013 of the first Respondent to the limited extent of giving retrospective effect to the said order from 01.04.2013 and (2) Letter No.2112/CMPC/2015-1, Finance (CMPC) Department, dated 05.03.2015, to the limited extent of direction in Para 3 thereof for re-examination of pay of Junior Assistant / Typists with degree qualification w.e.f. 23.07.2013 and to recover the excess pay and



all other consequential orders issued by the Subordinate Authorities and to quash the same and to direct the Respondents to desists from reducing and re-fixing the pay of the Petitioners and from effecting any recovery from their pay and to refund any amount recovered from the Petitioners and to grant the petitioners periodical annual increments for all the years without any default.

COMMON ORDER

2.In the aforesaid circumstances, recording the aforesaid submission and endorsement of withdrawal made by the learned counsel for the petitioners to that effect, these writ petitions are dismissed as withdrawn, with permission to the petitioners to send fresh individual representations along with a copy of this order to the first respondent on or before 20.10.2017 and the first respondent is directed to dispassionately consider the said representations and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law on or before 30.11.2017. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
