3.Having regard to the limited nature of relief sought for by the petitioner, this Court without expressing any view on the correctness or entitlement of the claim made by the petitioner, directs the Competent Authority to dispassionately consider the representation of the petitioner dated 28.08.2017, made to the respondents and pass reasoned orders on merits in accordance with law and communicate such decision to the petitioner and file a report of such compliance before the Registrar (Judicial), Madurai Bench of Madras High Court, Madurai on or before 31.01.2018.

4.Accordingly, this Writ Petition is disposed with the aforesaid direction. No costs.
