Prayer in W.P (MD) No.1976 of 2017: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records relating to the impugned order passed by the fourth respondent in his proceedings U.P.No.19684/A1/2014 dated Nil. 12.2014 and quash the same as illegal in so far as it relates to pass TET within a period of 5 years is concerned and the consequential order passed by the 4th respondent in his proceeding in Na.Ka.No. 07142/m2/2015 dated Nil.10.2015 (signed on 24.11.2015) and quashing the same and consequentially to direct the fourth respondent to disburse all monetary benefits including yearly increment and incentive increment without insisting the petitioner to pass Teacher Eligibility Test in conformity with the judgment rendered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Pramati Educational and*

Cultural Trust and others vs. Union of India and others reported in (2014) 4 MLJ 486 (SC).

Prayer in W.P(MD)No.1977 of 2017: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records relating to the impugned order passed by the fourth respondent in his proceedings மு.மு.எண்.19685/அ2/2014 dated 13.02.2015 and quash the same as illegal in so far as it relates to pass TET within a period of 5 years is concerned and consequentially to direct the 4th respondent to disburse all monetary benefits including yearly increment and incentive increment without insisting the petitioner to pass Teacher Eligibility Test in Conformity with judgement rendered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Pramati Educational and Cultural Trust and others vs. Union of India and others* reported in (2014) 4 MLJ 486 (SC).
