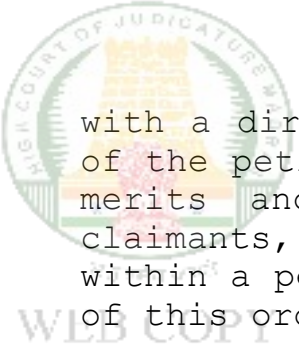
2.Mr.C.Selvaraj, learned Special Government Pleader takes notice for the respondents.
