ORDER

This writ petition has been filed, seeking to direct the respondents to conduct the survey on the basis of their application dated 23.08.2017.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents. By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

3. The case of the petitioners are that there is neither civil suit nor rival claim whatsoever pending in respect of the property in question and as such, they have submitted an application dated 23.08.2017 for measurement and survey of the property. Since the said application has not been considered so far, the petitioners



are before this Court with the above prayer.

4. Considering the facts and circumstance of the case and also taking into account the limited scope of the relief sought for by the petitioners, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matters, directs the respondents, more particularly, the first respondent to consider the application/representation of the petitioners dated 23.08.2017 and pass suitable orders regarding measurement of the property on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners as well as other interested parties, if any.

5. With the above direction, this petition is disposed of. No costs.
