The petitioner is aggrieved by issuance of patta granted on account of mistake that took place during UDR. To correct any UDR mistake, the aggrieved party must move the District Revenue Officer. In this case, the writ petitioner appears to have moved the Revenue Divisional Officer. It is not correct.

2.When the writ petition came up for hearing, the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner sought permission of this Court to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to move the appropriate authority. He has also made an endorsement to that effect.
