ORDER

2.It is seen that the first respondent, through his proceedings dated 05.10.2016, directed the second respondent, to take action on the petitioner's representation, in accordance with law and inform the same to the complainants.

This writ petition is disposed of only with a direction to the second respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 15.09.2016 and pass orders on the same on merits and in accordance with law, after hearing all the parties concerned including the parties against whom the petitioner and others made such complaint, within a period of 12 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
