2.In view of the submission and endorsement made by the the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, this writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. No costs.

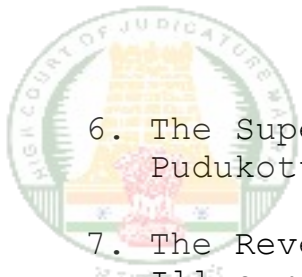
