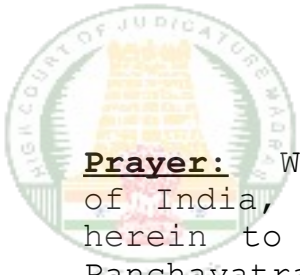

2.Heard Mr.A.P.Muthupandian, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.R.Velmurugan, learned Government Advocate and Mr.P.Gunasekaran, learned counsel, who take notice on behalf of the respondents. By consent of both parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3.Having regard to the limited nature of relief sought for by the petitioner, without expressing any view on the correctness or entitlement of the claim made, the first respondent is directed to dispassionately consider the representation dated 28.08.2017 made by the petitioner and pass reasoned orders on merits in accordance with law and communicate the same to the petitioner and file report of such compliance before the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court on or before 28.02.2018.
