



4.The learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents submitted that if reasonable time is granted to the respondents, the representation of the petitioner will be considered and appropriate orders will be passed.

5.In view of the said submission made by the learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondent, this Court, without going into the merits of the matter, directs the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 22.12.2016 and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

6.With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
