By consent, the writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

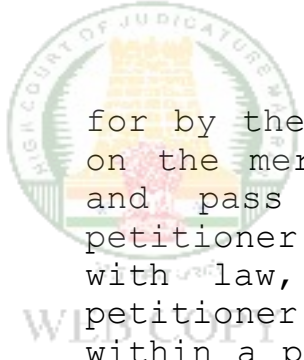
2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.M.Alagathevan, learned Special Government Pleader, who takes notice for the respondent.

According to the petitioner, the subject mentioned property belongs to him and neither civil suit nor rival claim, whatsoever, is pending in respect of the same and as such, he has submitted several representations, seeking Patta in his name. Since the said representations has not been considered so far, the petitioner is before this Court with the above prayer.

4. When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that it would suffice, if the latest representation of the petitioner dated 06.12.2017, is disposed of, by the respondent, on merits and within a stipulated time limit.
