ORDER

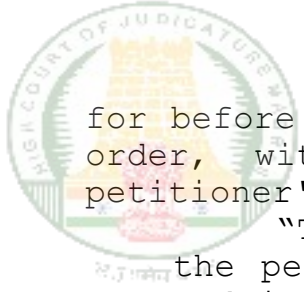
Writ Petition is filed for directing the respondent No.2 herein to consider the appointment of the petitioner as Associate Professor (Dentist) with consequential benefits.
