Prayer in W.P.3354/2017 : Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to accept the petitioner's application No. CR487483 and permit him to take part in the Written and other consequential Tests for recruitment to the post of Grade-II Police Constable as per the Advertisement No.117 by relaxing the age limit of the petitioner by one month based on the representation sent by the petitioner dated 08.02.2017.

Prayer in W.P.3358/2017 : Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to accept the petitioner's application No. CR892003 and permit him to take part in the Written and other consequential Tests for recruitment to the post of Grade-II Police Constable as per the Advertisement No.117 by relaxing the age limit of the petitioner by one year and one month based on the representation sent by the petitioner dated 08.02.2017.

COMMON ORDER

The petitioners have sought for a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to accept their applications and permit them to take part in the written and other consequential tests for recruitment to the post of Grade-II Police Constable as per the



Advertisement No.117 by giving relaxation of age by one month and one year respectively, based on their representations dated 08.02.2017.

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2.The recruitment process is exclusively vests with the respondent and it is based on rules and regulations and therefore, this Court cannot interfere with the same. If the relief sought for is granted, it will amount to opening Pandora's box and the respondent cannot recruit any person and the entire administration will be standstill.

Hence, these Writ Petitions are dismissed. No costs.
