3.Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondent to pass an order on the representation of the petitioner dated 09.12.2016 on merits and in accordance with law after giving due opportunity of rival claimants. Such exercise shall be done by the respondent, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
