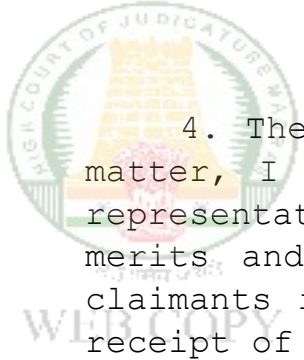

3. The petitioner seeks for a direction to the respondents for survey of his land in survey Nos.501/2, 501/4, 507/5 and 479 in Kookal Village, Kodaikanal, Dindigul District. To that effect, he has already made a representation on 12.01.2016, which, according to the petitioner, has not been considered so far.

Therefore, without expressing any view on the merits of the matter, I only direct the second respondent to consider the above representation of the petitioner and pass orders on the same, on merits and in accordance with law, also after hearing the rival claimants if any, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of.
