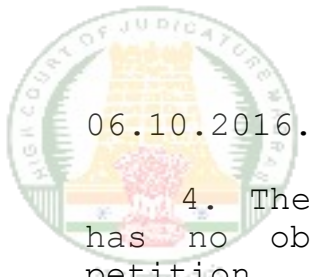

O R D E R

This writ petition has been filed for a writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to settle the petitioner's surrender leave salary of Rs.82,462/- for 72 days from 2009-2014 together with interest at the rate of 18% per annum payable from the date of retirement to till the date of actual payment.

2. The facts in this case are not in dispute. In similar circumstances, this Court has directed the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for payment of earned leave surrender salary.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the judgment of this Court in W.P.(MD).No.17789 of 2016 dated



06.10.2016.

4. The learned Standing counsel appearing for the respondents has no objection for passing the similar order in this writ petition.

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5. Considering the representations of counsel on either side, this Court is inclined to pass the following directions:

The respondents are directed to consider the claim of the petitioner for payment of the earned leave surrender salary in respect of the years 2009 - 2014 and pay the eligible amount to the petitioner as per the commitment made by the respondents under Section 12(3) Settlement within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
