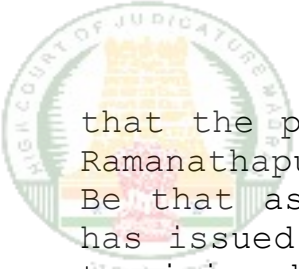

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Standing Counsel, who accepts notice for the respondents. By consent, the Writ Petition itself is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission.

2. The petitioner seeks to quash the impugned note of the second respondent dated 10.02.2017, which is not an order and therefore, it is not a justiciable and the impugned note states



that the petitioner should approach the Principal District Judge, Ramanathapuram. Therefore, the Writ Petition is not maintainable. Be that as it may, the Principal District Judge, Ramanathapuram, has issued a memorandum dated 16.03.2017, directing the petitioner to join duty as Watchman in the second respondent Court. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to join duty, as per the said order.

3. In view of the above, there is no further order necessary in the Writ Petition. Hence, recording the proceedings of the Principal District Judge, Ramanathapuram, dated 16.03.2017, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
