PRAYER: Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the first respondent to dispose of the petitioner's appeal, dated 21.12.2016 preferred by him as against the order passed by the second respondent in Ref.No.Sattam/SA4/6652/5B/2013, dated 19.02.2014 in imposing the punishment of increment cut for a period of six months with cumulative effects upon the petitioner, within a time frame that may be fixed by this Court.

5. Accordingly, the Writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
