This Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to call for records relating to the

necessary direction to give permission for conducting Adal Padal Programme in the place mentioned therein, by way of issuing a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus.

2.Mr.M.Govindan, learned Special Government Pleader, has taken notice for the respondents.

3.It is seen from the records that the representation given by the petitioner has been rejected by the second respondent simply on the ground of law and order problem. The reason assigned by the second respondent is not bonafide and therefore this Court is inclined the pass the following order.

4.In fine, this Writ Petition is allowed in part without costs and the rejection order dated 12.03.2017 passed by the second respondent is quashed. The second respondent is directed to consider the representation afresh and dispose of the same on merits within a period of two days and if there is any law and order problem, the second respondent is directed to take proper action. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
