O R D E R

Though the Writ petition is for issuing a positive direction, the learned counsel for the petitioner submit that the petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is issued to the first respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 07.03.2017 within the time stipulated by this Court.

5. Having regard to the limited scope of the prayer now made by the counsel for the petitioner in the Writ petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, this Court is inclined to issue the following direction:-

"The respondents are directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 07.03.2017, and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order."

6. Accordingly, the Writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
