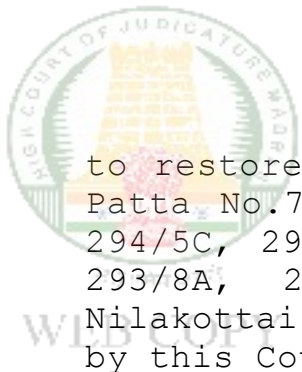

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Additional Government Pleader, who takes notice for the respondents 1 to 3.

3. Needless to say that it is for the first respondent to dispose of the said revision after giving opportunity of hearing to the petitioners as well as the rival claimants, if any and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law.

Therefore, without expressing any view on the claim made by the petitioners, the first respondent is directed to dispose of the revision filed by the petitioners after giving opportunity of hearing to the petitioners as well as the rival claimants, if any and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
