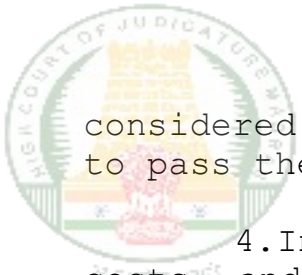
### ORDER
