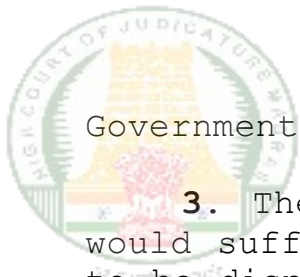

Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that it would suffice if the representation of the petitioner is directed to be disposed of, on merits and in accordance with law, within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

In view of the limited scope of the prayer in the Writ petition, without going into the merits of the matter, the respondents are directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 14.02.2017 and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law, in the light of the Circular No.67, dated 03.11.2011, issued by the first respondent, after giving an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner as well as the other parties concerned, if any, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. With the above direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
