"The respondents are is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 18.10.2016, and pass appropriate orders purely on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order."

6. Accordingly, the Writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
