2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

3. Mr. C. Selvaraj, learned Special Government Pleader, takes notice for the respondents. By consent, the Writ petition itself is taken up for final disposal.

4. Having regard to the limited scope of the prayer in the Writ petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, this Court is inclined to issue the following direction:-

"The respondents 1 and 2 are directed to finalize the proceedings initiated in No.R.C.933/2014/CP, dated 27.07.2015, by the Deputy Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Ramanathapuram, under section 82 of the Co-operative Societies Act, 1983, and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order."

5. Accordingly, the Writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
