cannot grant emergency leave and it is only the Deputy Inspector General for Prisons.

In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to make representation to the Deputy Inspector General for Prisons and on such representation being made, the same shall be considered by the Deputy Inspector General for Prisons and the Deputy Inspector General for Prisons may also explore the possibility of sending the prisoner under the police escort in the morning and bringing him back in the evening.

5. With the above directions, this Writ Petition is closed.
