ORDER

The Petitioner seeks for a direction to the second respondent to consider the Petitioner's representation dated 15.12.2016 for granting patta for three acres and 17 cents of land to the Petitioner's land in S.Nos.145 and 145/1A in Narkani Village, Kalaiyarkovil Taluk, Sivagangai District in accordance with law within the time stipulated by this Court.

3. By consent of both parties, the main Writ Petition is taken up for disposal, at the admission stage itself.

4. The grievance of the Petitioner is that the above said representation submitted by the Petitioner to grant patta for three acres and 17 cents of land to the Petitioner's land in S.Nos.145 and 145/1A in Narkani Village, Kalaiyarkovil Taluk, Sivagangai District, has not been considered so far.

5. Considering the limited scope of the prayer sought for and without expressing any view on the merits of the claim made by the Petitioner, I only direct the third respondent to consider the representation of the Petitioner, dated 15.12.2016 and pass orders on the same, on merits and in accordance with law, also by hearing other rival parties, if any, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
