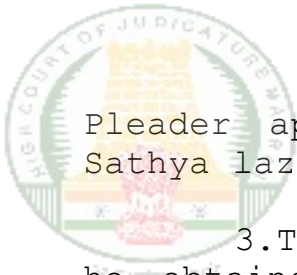

The petitioner has filed this Writ Petition to direct the respondent school to issue altered Transfer Certificate for his minor son namely Guna by making necessary corrections with regard to the religion as Budhism and correction of the petitioner's name as Akilan instead of Arockiya Alexander Raj.

3.The respondent school has informed the petitioner that if he obtains appropriate order from the educational authorities, then, they will consider the same. Therefore, we are of the opinion that the petitioner cannot be aggrieved by the communication dated 08.05.2017 sent by the principal of the school by the petitioner. Therefore, the question of challenging the said proceedings does not arise.

4.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner had submitted a representation to the third respondent. The learned Special Government Pleader submitted that sufficient time may be given to the third respondent to pass appropriate orders.

5.In the light of the same, the Writ Petition is disposed of by directing the petitioner to submit a fresh representation to the third respondent along with a copy of this order within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on receipt of such representation, the third respondent shall if necessary, obtain appropriate report from the fourth respondent school and pass an order on merits and in accordance with law within a period of two weeks thereafter.
