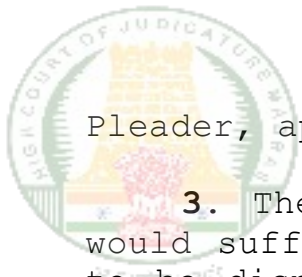

Pleader, appearing for the respondents.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that it would suffice if the representation of the petitioner is directed to be disposed of, on merits and in accordance with law, within the time stipulated by this Court.

In view of the limited scope of the prayer that is now sought before this Court by the learned counsel for the petitioner, without going into the merits of the petitioner's case, the respondents are directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, 09.05.2017, and pass orders positively on merits and in accordance with law, after giving an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner, within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. With the above direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. Consequently, the Miscellaneous petition is closed. No costs.
